Greetings RHS Families,

I hope this message finds you well, enjoying the falling leaves, and raking or blowing the appropriate amount of piles to keep your yard looking fresh before the frost.

I wanted to briefly share some of our building goals prior to presenting them at the board meeting this coming Monday. We began the year with specific foci in mind, and we remain committed to these goals, which will drive many of our decisions throughout the year:

- Supporting the IB MYP verification visit and launching the DP and CP courses, RHS staff will engage in ongoing PD with IB roundtables, internal meetings, and external trainings to ensure ongoing fidelity to IB standards. Part of this continuous improvement includes networking with the MNIB partner schools, building collaboration efforts with existing community partners, and building additional partnerships with local organizations.
- During the 2021-2022 school year implement two non-traditional drills where authentic situations are explored (i.e. passing time, lunch, before school, just after school). 100% of RHS staff will be ALICE Trained and communicate with students before, during, and after drills take place
- In the 2021-2022 school year decrease % of students failing courses, school-wide, by 5% compared to the 2020-2021 school year
- By 4th quarter every teacher incorporates a mindfulness activity at least once a week
- To reduce the number of iTeam referrals through refining processes and using tools for student self-advocacy
- By the end of the first quarter, 100% of students will have a mutual "strong connection" (HQC) with at least one staff member. A "strong connection" will be measured by utilizing the "dot activity".

We continue to exert our efforts fully to engage students in the teaching and learning process to address the learning loss, meet them where they are at, and prepare them adequately for college and career readiness.
