### **Graduation Requirements**

As a freshman in the graduating class of 2025, you will need:

- 8 English Credits
- 7 Social Studies Credits
- 6 Science Credits
- 6 Math Credits
- 2 Art Credits
- 1 Health Credit (can be taken in 10<sup>th</sup> grade)
- 1 Physical Education (can be taken in 9<sup>th</sup> grade)
- 1 Career and Technical Education course
- 18 Electives
- Total of 50 required credits

\*Can earn up to 56 credits

### **Registration Options**

As incoming freshmen, you will only register for your Elective classes:

 Band, Choir, Agriculture, AVID, Business, Engineering & Manufacturing Technology and World Language

We suggest that you take 2 Fine Art Credits your 9th grade

### What Happens If You Get an "F"

- Begin with the end in mind.
- Grades "matter"
- Your transcript is a document that many folks (future employers, college admission officers, etc.) will be Very interested in
- What do you want them to see???
- If you get an "F," you will need to repeat the class or make it up in night school or summer school.
- If you receive an "F" it stays on your transcript.
- Make sure to keep track of your grades and transcript. You don't want to have to take a freshman level course as a senior.

- 1) Go to the district website at www.rockford.k12.mn.us.
- 2) Click on the Infinite Campus Portal icon
- 3) Login using the student's Username and Password (use your school password)
- 4) Use the QR Code below for a link to the registration instructions
- Once complete, review your plan with a parent/legal guardian and check the "Approved by parent/legal guardian" box at the top
- 5) SAVE your course plan
- 6) Remember to logout when finished

\*Your course choices matter. We are basing our schedule on student demand. Courses that do not have enough interest will not be offered during the 2022-23 school year.

#### How to Register:

- Review each subject for the upcoming grade you are registering for.
- Pre-filled courses with the lock icon are pre-determined based on teacher recommendation and cannot be changed during the registration process.
- For subjects where a course is not pre-filled, click within the box and a drop down list of available courses will appear. Select the course you wish to enroll in. If you select an "A" semester course, the "B" course will auto fill. If it does not, make sure to select the "B" semester course as well.
- If a course number is entered in error, click on the (x) by the course name to remove it.
- If a course is pre-filled, but not locked, you could elect to enroll in a different course than the pre-filled course by following these instructions:
  - Click the "x" next to the course name to delete the course
  - After the course is deleted, click in the box and a drop down list will appear of available courses. Select the course you wish to enroll in. If you select an "A" semester course, the "B" course will auto fill. If it does not, make sure to select the "B" semester course as well.

### **Online Registration FINAL STEPS!**

You are finished when you have 14.0/14.0 credits at the top of the column AND the required credits from each subject area are met for your upcoming year. You only need to register for the upcoming school year. Students can make course selections for future years following the same procedures. These courses will be saved in their planner, but not locked in, and can be changed later.

Review your course plan with a parent/ guardian.

Click "Save" in the top menu bar. Remember, this will only "lock in" the courses you selected for the next academic year. You may print your Academic Plan by clicking on the printer icon at the top by "Course Plan Report".

Congratulations! Your registration is complete.

**IMPORTANT:** Final Schedules are based on student demand. Courses that did not have enough interest may not be offered and you may be asked to select an alternative course. When schedules are released, if you have a "See Counselor" in one block instead of an actual course, you will need to see the Guidance Office to fill your schedule within the first 2 days of school. This can happen if courses you selected are full, do not fit in your schedule, or if not enough electives were selected during the registration process.
